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Minutes of Planning, Development Control & Highways Committee Meeting held on 24th July 2019 at +7.00pm at Tidenham War Memorial Hall.

1. ATTENDANCE

- c. **Resolved not to Comment** on the main amendments to the Gloucestershire Minerals Local Plan.

7. TO CONSIDER PLANNING APPLICATIONS RECEIVED

Resolved to comment as follows:

- a. **P0894/19/FUL** - Rose Cottage Beachley Chepstow NP16 7HG.
Erection of a single storey extension to existing annexe accommodation all to be used ancillary to the main dwelling. (retrospective).
No Objection – Concerns were raised that although this is stated as an extension to be used ancillary to the main dwelling, a kitchen has been included and the extension appears to have its own front door access separate to the main dwelling.

b. P0988/19/FUL - 10 Arlington Court Sedbury Chepstow NP16 7EZ.
Erection of a single storey front/side extension with associated works.
No Objection.

c. P1007/19/FUL - 4 Coleford Road Tutshill Chepstow NP16 7BN.
Erection of a first floor extension over existing rear and a single storey rear extension to provide additional downstairs living.
No Objection.

d. P0896/19/FUL - Highbury Miss Graces Lane Tidenham Chase Chepstow NP16 7JR.
Construction of an equestrian manege.
No Objection.

e. P1000/19/FUL - Chancefield (formerly The Old Nursery) Boughspring Lane Tidenham Chase Chepstow NP16 7JL.
Erection of a replacement dwelling and triple garage with associated works. Demolition of existing dwelling and garage. (Revised scheme).

Discharge of conditions 08 (remediation works), 11 (external lighting scheme), 12 (landscape and ecological management plan) and 15 (surface water drainage) relating to planning permission P0454/17/FUL.
Objection – Discharge of Condition 8 not met. Councillors were concerned that the ground under the proposed building number 2 has not been cleared of asbestos waste which may in future pose contamination issues.

Erection of 2 No. dwellings and 2 No. garages with associated access, landscaping, parking and works.

Application under section 191 to establish whether use of land as residential curtilage is lawful.
Lawful Development Certificate Issued.

Erection of a tree house with associated works.

- b. **Resolved to note** -Excess litter on A48 in Parish – reported to FoDDC.
- c. **Resolved to note** the following reported to Glos CC Highways:
 - Caravan parked on road in Wyebank Way causing obstruction.
 - Offa's Dyke footpath - overgrown Stourgrove Lane to Netherhope Lane.
 - Roadmarker next to Woodcroft bus shelter broken at ground level.
- d. **Resolved to note** A466 road closure update from Monmouthshire County Council.

12. TO REPORT ON HIGHWAY ISSUES

Resolved to note the following:

- a. **To note** Zebra crossings in Sedbury Village – from Glos CC Highways: Thank you for raising this enquiry. These beacons are in line with the manufacturers specifications and under TSRGD guidelines – which would appear to be black in this instance. Google maps 2017 shows these as black, which would indicate that they are simply dirty. I will raise a job for our contractor to attend and inspect and clean as necessary.
- b. **To note** No flag on bus stop opposite Wyedean School, Beachley Rd – from Glos CC Highways: Enquiry passed to Integrated Transport.
- c. **To note** 2 overgrown patches of grass that have not been cut and are obscuring views of traffic – 1) on the corner of Grahamstown Rd and Beachley Rd and 2) at the top of Tylers Way - From Glos CC Highways: Scheduled for cutting 27 June.
- d. **To note** broken poles on centre island leaving the Sedbury/Beachley Rd roundabout - from Glos CC Highways: Passed to Local Highways representative.
- e. **To note** Woodcroft and Tutshill signs –new sign for Woodcroft has been replaced at the approach from Tutshill instead of from the Coleford approach – reported to Glos CC Highways.
- f. **To note** Castleford Hill - re-occurrence of large depression – from Glos CC Highways: re-assigned to local safety inspection team.

Resolved to defer consideration until the next meeting of nominated councillor each month to be responsible for receiving and reviewing paper planning documents prior to the meeting and for these documents to be available for Committee members to view 15 minutes before each meeting. Councillor Wall volunteered to review the paper planning documents for August.

Chris Wall – since the meeting on Castleford Hill with Brian Watkins, nothing has been done with regard to the issues raised, particularly the overgrown footpath, overgrown trees, 30mph sign obscured, gutters overgrown and not cleared and the grassed area at the bottom of Mopla Road not having been cut. Clerk to raise these issues again with Brian Watkins.

Also – 20mph School sign on Coleford road obscured again.

Councillor Bollen – bench outside of St John's School has been vandalised.
